

Only Natural Pet Store Flea Control Kits for Cats

The adult female flea can lay from 10 to 50 eggs a day. Considering an adult flea can live up to 60-100 days, a single flea could lay upwards of 2000 eggs in her lifetime. And even if only half of those go on to reproduce...well; you get the picture – lots and lots of fleas! Therefore, it is important to act quickly and thoroughly once you discover the problem.

Keep in mind that the healthier the animal the less appealing they are to fleas – so take a close look at your companion's diet and nutrition.

Mild Infestation Kit:

- Flea Comb: The ultimate weapon in the battle with fleas is the Flea Comb. As you comb your companion you will trap fleas in the comb. Drown them in SOAPY water – fleas have been known to jump out of plain water. Flea combing daily may sound tedious, but it is very helpful while you are working on the environmental control measures necessary to rid your companion's world of fleas. Just remember that for every adult flea you drown in that soapy water you are preventing generations of future parasites from searching for food in your home.
- Only Natural Pet All-in-One Flea Remedy – Use as directed on bottle. Use both on your pet and in around the house. Concentrate on areas that your companion spends the most time and keep in mind that flea larva like to hide UNDER furniture and area rugs. The All-in-One Flea Remedy dehydrates the fleas quickly and can begin to kill fleas within 48 hours.
- Only Natural Pet Brewer's Yeast and Garlic Tablets – Garlic and B vitamins tend to make the animal less tasty to fleas. Brewer's yeast is a good source of B vitamins. Follow dosage instructions on the bottle.

Please Note: We HIGHLY recommend feeding the best diet you can to help boost your companion's health and resistance to pests. If your companion is prone to itching, avoid common allergens such as wheat, soy, corn, beef and chicken in food *and* treats. Additional Items in Moderate Infestation Kit:

- Only Natural Pet Herbal Defense Shampoo and Conditioner: Bathing your companion is an excellent way to kill fleas. Shampoo thoroughly and leave the lather on your pet for a few minutes to help smother any persistent fleas, and then RINSE WELL. Soap residue can dry the skin and make the itchiness worse. Follow with Only Natural Herbal Defense Conditioner to moisturize the skin and coat. Clip off any matted fur to remove flea hiding places.

Additional Items in Severe Infestation Kit:

- Doc Ackerman's Hot Spot Relief Spray: Use as directed to soothe red, inflamed itchy skin.
- FleaBusters: This is a boric acid based powder and works in a similar fashion to the All-in-One Remedy by dehydrating the fleas, but takes up to two weeks to make a noticeable difference in the flea population. When applied correctly, FleaBusters can offer protection for up to a year as the powder remains deep in the carpet fibers. Fleabusters may also be used on hard floors as the powder is fine enough to reach into cracks and crevices well. Both products may be used on furniture. All visible powder must be worked into the carpet, floor or furniture well with a push broom or rake, and any remaining visible powder should be vacuumed up. This powder is NOT for use directly on the animal.

With all flea powder products common sense caution must be used. Follow package directions carefully. They are drying agents, and therefore irritate nasal passages and lungs if inhaled directly. Avoid overzealous shaking of the container while spreading it onto the floor so you don't create clouds of dust. Move pets to another room before applying.
