

Only Natural Pet Store Itchy Skin & Allergy Kits for Cats

It is important to rule out other possible causes of your companion's itchiness such as fleas, mange, ringworm or infection. Keep in mind that any secondary bacterial or yeast infections must be treated before much progress can be seen in remediation of the underlying cause of the itchy skin. Hot spots can occur from self trauma that results when the pet attempts to relieve a pain or itch by excessive scratching, biting and rubbing. These hot spots must be controlled with topical treatments while the animal's immune system is recovering.

Basic Kit:

Only Natural Pet Salmon Oil – Start with ½ the dosage recommended on the bottle for your cat's weight (add to food) and gradually increase to full dose over several days. The dosage can be increased to 1 1/2 to 2 times that recommended on the bottle if needed – do this gradually over the course of a week. Dosage can be split between two meals. If your cat develops loose stools, then reduce the dosage a bit.

Salmon oil provides Essential Fatty Acids (EFA's), which nourish your companion's skin and coat and help reduce inflammation.

Animal Essentials Plant Enzymes & Probiotics – These should be given at EVERY meal. Enzymes are dosed by volume of food, not by the weight of the animal. Follow dosage instructions on the container for each meal.

Digestive enzymes aid in the breakdown of food and enhance nutrition while probiotics support the restoration of beneficial gut flora and the healing of the digestive tract.

Please Note: We HIGHLY recommend using a high quality allergy formula food while treating your cat for allergies and itchy skin. Avoid common allergens such as wheat, soy, corn, beef and chicken. Additional Items in Deluxe Kit:

Days 1 & 2 add the Salmon Oil and Digestive Enzymes to the diet. After adding the above supplements to your companion's diet for 3 days, begin adding the Nature's Herbs Itch Relief for Cats on day 4 or 5.

Nature's Herbs Itch Relief for Cats – This is a natural remedy to relieve red, itchy and inflamed skin and promote healing. A treatment course is typically 4-5 weeks.

Dosage: 1 pill twice daily

Pets can take Nature's Herbs 1 hour before or after any medication. Remedies can be taken on a full or empty stomach. Please do not use on pregnant pets.

Please keep in mind that response to herbal remedies varies by individual. If your pet's symptoms worsen or change in any way that concerns you or if vomiting or diarrhea occur, discontinue use of any supplements and contact your veterinarian.

On day 6 add the only natural Pet Immune Balance.

Only Natural Pet Immune Balance - A well-balanced immune system is especially important in helping to treat allergies, which are often characterized by an overactive immune system. Unlike an immune booster, which stimulates the immune system, this all-natural liquid supplement brings it into balance.

Shake well before using. Dose directly into mouth or add to small treat. 1 ml = 20 drops. It is recommended to be given on an empty stomach between meals.

Dosage:

Up to 16 lbs: 4-7 drops daily

Over 17 lbs: 8 - 15 drops daily

(Approximately 1 drop per 2.2 lbs.)
