

Only Natural Pet Store Stomach & Gastrointestinal Kit for Cats

Alternative treatment of gastrointestinal issues always begins with diet. At a minimum an animal with stomach or gastrointestinal troubles needs a very high quality canned food with no fillers or artificial preservatives. If you feed some kibble try an allergy formula or grain-free formula. Better yet would be the addition of raw or home prepared foods (properly balanced by following a recipe).

Kit Includes:

Only Natural Pet Salmon Oil – Start with ½ the dosage recommended on the bottle for your cat's weight (add to food) and gradually increase to full dose over several days. The dosage can be increased to 1 1/2 to 2 times that recommended on the bottle if needed – do this gradually over the course of a week. Dosage can be split between two meals. If your cat develops loose stools, then reduce the dosage a bit.

Salmon oil provides Essential Fatty Acids (EFA's), which help reduce inflammation and nourish your companion's skin, coat and digestive tract.

Animal Essentials Plant Enzymes & Probiotics – These should be given at EVERY meal. Enzymes are dosed by volume of food, not by the weight of the animal. Follow dosage instructions on the container for each meal.

Digestive enzymes aid in the breakdown of food and enhance nutrition while probiotics support the restoration of beneficial gut flora and the healing of the digestive tract. (As this formula contains only 1 strain of probiotic we include the Wysong Pet Inoculant in our Stomach and GI Kit)

NF Spectra Probiotic – Give these at least 2 times per day in a meal or treat. (If possible, give ½ - 1 hour prior to breakfast and 2 hours after dinner). These tablets break and crush easily and can be mixed in canned food or meat juice.

Dosage: ½ tablet 2 times per day

NF Spectra Probiotic contains 8 strains of probiotics along with prebiotics (FOS) and N-acetyl-D-glucosamine for optimal therapeutic benefits to the gastrointestinal tract.
